Nut-Free Policy

We have noticed that some children are bringing items that contain nuts in their lunch boxes. Dedham Church of England Primary School aims to be a nut-free school. In order to reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer an anaphylactic reaction if exposed to nuts to which they are sensitive, we do not allow nuts or nut products in school lunch boxes. The following items should not be brought into school:

- Packs of nuts
- Peanut butter sandwiches
- Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
- Sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- Cakes made with nuts

Colchester School of Gymnastics – Half Term Activities

We will be running classes during the February half term holidays for children who would like to have a taster of gymnastics classes. I have attached a copy of our poster.

We are also running a free open event on Monday 18th February. The aim of the event is to raise awareness of the importance of sport and fitness in children, and to allow the children the opportunity to try their hand at gymnastics. The children will get the opportunity to try all the apparatus and hopefully learn some new skills in our 2 state of the art purpose-built gymnasiums.

We have two sessions running on this day. The first session is 11am-1pm for children age 4-7 and the second session is 1.30pm-3.30pm for age 8+ (maximum of 15 years old). Children are welcome to come for the whole session, or just part of it. Some of our coaches will be on hand to offer parents and the children advice and to highlight the many benefits health and lifestyle of gymnastics. Our reception team will also be on hand to discuss availability and suitability of our classes.

We will also have some of our Elite squad of gymnasts in training, many of who have been with the club from pre-school, through recreational classes and now enjoy success at County, Regional and National competitions. The gymnasts will be on hand to answer any questions the children may have, share their experiences and show off the skills they have learned.

There will be free hot drinks available throughout the event.

Please note that there will be activities taking place at Colchester Museums across all three sites; Colchester Castle, The Natural History Museum and Hollytrees Museum.


