This year, the main focus of Comic relief is supporting the plight of Refugees. We have invited Refugee Action Colchester to come into school on Friday 15th March to talk to us about their projects and to give us some insight into the journeys some of the refugees in our own community have gone through.

During the course of the week the children will also be exploring art produced by refugees to illustrate their journeys. They will be using these as inspiration to create their own pieces. These will be showcased in an exhibition after school on Friday 15th. We hope you will come and visit our art exhibition and support Refugee Action Colchester by making a small entry donation.

In addition to this, school council will be selling Red Noses starting on Monday 11th March. Each nose now costs £1.25. We ask that children buy only one nose initially from us to allow everyone to buy one if they would like to. If there are any left over the remainder will be sold on a first come first served basis.
