KS2 Production (Wed 17th & Thurs 18th)

A few reminders for parents ahead of next week's KS2 Production.

- Remember that Wednesday's performance begins at 6pm and Thursday's performance at 7pm.
- The school playground will be open for parking on both evenings.
- Children in years 3-5 will be let into school fifteen minutes before the performance begins.
- Children in year 6 will be let into school half an hour before the performance begins.
- ALL children MUST wait with an adult until a member of staff calls them in. Children must not play on the field or run around the playground because cars will be parking.
- Children in years 3-5 will take their production t-shirts home on the

Tuesday afternoon and should therefore arrive at school each evening dressed ready in their Snow White tshirt (or a plain black short sleeved tshirt) and blue denim jeans/shorts/skirts etc.

• The production lasts for approximately 45 minutes.

Please note that the performances are ticket only. We have a specified number of seats available and all the tickets have been allocated. Additional people cannot come along to the performance without a ticket. Please do not embarrass yourselves/ us by turning up without a ticket.

Small children cannot come along as additional extras and sit on their adults lap.

REMINDER - Notice for Parents of Children in Year 3 from September 2019 - Free School Meals

Automatic entitlement to a free school meal finishes at the end of Year 2 and only children from low income families are eligible from Year 3.

If your household income is less than £16,190 per year, or you receive Income Support or an equivalent benefit, you will need to make an application immediately if you want your child to receive a free school meal now.
