Dear families of Dedham CE Primary School,

As I reflect on the past three and a half months since the full opening of schools in September I feel enormous pride and gratitude for what has been achieved at Dedham. The overriding strength of our community, family even, has enabled the school to continue moving forwards even during such challenging times.

I am grateful to parents for supporting the school in implementing protective measures including seeking a test when necessary and following self-isolation guidance. Over 60 children at our school have been required to self-isolate awaiting test results or due to contact with a positive case of Covid19. Contact tracing during the Christmas break

Following our newsletter last week about arrangements for the end of term and for contact tracing over the Christmas break, please note the following:

- The last day of term is Friday 18th December—school finishes at the normal time on this day.
- If your child develops symptoms of Covid-19 within 48 hours of being in school (before Monday 21 December) please contact the school by email to let us know and seek a test for your child. Your household must isolate at home until the test result is returned. If the test result is positive for Covid-19, you must let us know so that we can identify any other individuals within the school community who are impacted by this. If the test result is negative, please let us know but you do not need to take any further action.
- If your child has no symptoms but has a positive Covid-19 test within 48 hours of being school (before Monday 21 December) please let us know by email so that we can identify any other individuals within the school community who have been a close contact of your child.

- If your child develops symptoms of Covid-19 more than 48 hours after their last day in school (from Monday 21 December onwards) you must seek a test for your child and the household must isolate at home until the test result is returned. If the test result is positive for Covid-19 the contact tracing will be done by the NHS and not by the school. This means that you must contact NHS Test and Trace and follow the advice given by them: www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/

- The school reopens to pupils on Tuesday 5th January.

If your child is going to be absent on that day due to being unwell or self-isolating, please contact us to let us know. If you need to contact us during the holidays to share information about Covid symptoms or tests, please do so by email at office@dedham.essex.sch.uk.

This will be monitored between 9am and 1pm until Thursday 24th December. Emails sent after this date and non-urgent emails sent to this address during the holidays will be replied to when the school reopens in January.
